ORDER NO. E&TW3 – 53599/2017 DATED 14..12..2017.

The Kerala Forest Protective Staff Association submitted a representation stating that as the Ecotourism sites are managed by the Vana Samrakshana Samithis/Eco Development Committees they are collecting service charges from all the tourists visiting the area. The forest department officials who wish to visit such Ecotourism sites in forest areas are also bound to pay the entry tickets and the fee for other service charges. The Forest Protective Staff who are doing the protection of our valuable forest in adverse conditions in the forest area need to enjoy some concessions while they visit Ecotourism areas inside forest with their family members. The issue was placed in the Council of the Chief Conservator of Forests and the Council has agreed the suggestion that free entry should be allowed to members of the Forest Protective Staff and their family while visiting ecotourism sites managed by the VSS/EDC.

In this circumstances I, Prakriti Srivastava, APCCF (E&TW) and Member Secretary, SFDA do here by order that all the members of Forest Protective Staff of the department and their family members will be allowed free entry to the ecotourism sites while they visit the sites. It will be compulsory that the staff himself should produce the departmental ID card and should be present along with his family members to avail the above said concession.
